Since our last newsletter, we have conducted our summer Shareholder Informational Meeting, which was one of the best turnouts since I have been with Eklutna. About 40 people were in attendance, and we enjoyed a lively question-and-answer session along with a fun raffle. Please remember to get your stock wills on file and updated so that your name will be included in the next stock will raffle, coming up during our Annual Meeting in November.

Eklutna, Inc. will soon be publishing a video concerning the North Anchorage Land Agreement (NALA), which pertains to future entitlement land. Once this video is finished, we will ensure that you receive a digital copy. I encourage you to share it with your friends and family, as we will work with the delegation and our team to forge the best path forward on this issue.

In the business aspect of our company, I would like to update you on a few key areas:

- We currently have only one office vacancy, located at Artillery Park.
- The sand and gravel operation has finished crushing Hard Rock at the Rock Alaska site location, and they will hopefully be delivering all the rock produced to Kiewit on the JBER runway extension this upcoming spring.
- The construction company is in a flurry of bidding, as the federal year-end is September 30. They are currently very busy finishing up Anchorage School District jobs, as the start of the school year is here.

In conclusion, I want to express my gratitude for your continued support and engagement with Eklutna, Inc. Your participation and interest are vital to our success, and we look forward to sharing more exciting developments with you in the near future.

**Eklutna Land Holdings** 

A question asked during the Shareholder Information Meeting was how many acres of developable land remains in Eklutna's assets. The Land Department tracks the land assets owned by the Corporation which includes the original ANCSA conveyance which was approximately 126,000 acres. Throughout the years, other land has been conveyed to or traded with the Corporation as well as land has been identified within the North Anchorage Land Agreement (NALA), as owed to Eklutna if base downsizing would occur. Over the last 10 years, 235.60 acres has been developed as residential subdivision lots or sold raw land by the Corporation.

Using mapping databases held by the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) and Matanuska Susitna Borough (MSB), the following summary provides part of the information related to that question. These acreages are counted within the MOA and MSB systems and are only the acres that are included as part of the MOA and MSB property data.

Remaining Within MOA:

Developable Acres 8.941.71 acres Non-Developable Acres 2,674.33 acres

Remaining Within MSB:

3,658.08 acres Developable Acres 6.109.86 acres Non-Developable Acres

The remaining information to fully answer the question includes the Corporation also owns 70,800 acres of land which are not included in the MOA and MSB's databases. Additionally, there are approximately 15,000 acres yet to be conveyed to Eklunta, Inc. along the Knik River.

preference when bidding on federal contracts. The HUBZone program fuels small business growth in historically underutilized business zones with a goal of awarding at least 3% of federal contract dollars to HUBZone-certified companies each year. Coupling the HUBZone certification with the 8(a) certification gives ECM an incredible bidding advantage on contracts.

The Anchorage office of ECM includes a large shop, maintenance area, tool storage, and office space. This location was chosen strategically to create more efficiencies when working on contracts located on Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson (JBER). This business site is right next to the IBER base, within five minutes of access. There is strategic and financial benefit to having materials, supplies, repair shop, tools,

and equipment in close proximity to on-going projects. Both the Anchorage and Wasilla offices boost well equipped conference rooms allowing productive video and audio meetings with the entire project team including federal contracting officers who may be located all





Watch for a booklet with this cover page containing information about the Annual Meeting as well as all the approved candidate information who are running for a Director position. Below is an example of a Proxy executed by Shareholder John Doe who has 500 votes to cast. The approved candidates for Directors are Betsy Ross, George Washington, Elvis Presley, and Elizabeth Taylor.

In this sample, Mr. Doe would complete the line in the heading (highlighted in yellow with red font for reference in this sample) to state Betsy Ross and George Washington. He appoints Betsy Ross as the primary proxy holder with George Washington as the alternate.

Mr. Doe authorizes his 500 votes be voted by Ms. Ross. However, he has designated that 300 votes be cast for Betsy Ross and 200 votes cast for George Washington. Ms. Ross can not alter those vote designations.

# **Orthodox Church and Eklutna Cemetery**

Shareholders may have been hearing about the Orthodox Church at Eklutna Village scheduled to go under restoration construction. The Eklutna's Land Department, Eklutna's Cemetery Committee, and the Native Village of Eklutna management team have been monitoring this project. The Orthodox Church of America received a grant for restoration of several churches across Alaska, including at Eklutna Village. The group, Russian Orthodox Sacred Sites in Alaska


(ROSSIA), is a non-profit group leading the project. This group is setting up community information meetings to inform local residents of the future timelines and project work.

Eklutna's management team will be in attendance at these meeings and monitoring the project very closely. Eklutna's Cemetery Committee Members have also held meetings with the leader of the Orthodox Church and continue to be heavily involved to prevent infringement into the cemetery locations.



Staff has also been working this summer to continue updating the map information for the cemetery. Thank you to the Shareholders and families who helped by sharing their information and memories of loved ones within the old cemetery site, we have been able to identify a few more loved ones. The updated map is also located on the Burials tab of the website.

# **Traditions - The Cloth Ceremony**

The Athabascan cloth ceremony is a custom to celebrate and to memorialize, or remember, among people gathered in the spirit of unity. Traditionally, the cloth ceremony was held at the time of a funeral or memorial potlatch. Today, the cloth ceremony is more commonly held during Native freindship potlatches to celebrate friendship, unity and cooperation.

The guests form a circle in an open area, and a long cloth sewn into a continuous circle is distributed among the participants. While holding the cloth, the guests participate in dancing, singing and oratory. Songs are composed for the special event. During the ceremony, the cloth circle is cut or torn into individual pieces for each guest who together "dance the cloth" during the ceremony.
